


## UNEA Resolution 5/8: Science-Policy Panel to Contribute Further to the Sound Management of Chemicals and Waste and to Prevent Pollution

- ➤ In March 2022, the United Nations Environment Assembly decided that a science-policy panel should be established to contribute further to the sound management of chemicals and waste and prevent pollution, with details to be further specified according to the provisions in the resolution;
- ➤ UNEA further decided to convene an **ad hoc open-ended working group to prepare proposals for the science-policy panel**, to begin work in 2022 with the ambition of completing it by the end of 2024.


