Draft Chair's Summary

Agenda item 1: Opening of the meeting and adoption of the agenda.

- 1. H. E. Mr. Firas Khouri, Chair of the Committee of Permanent Representatives (CPR), Ambassador of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan to Kenya and Permanent Representative to the United Nations Environment Programme, opened the meeting.
- 2. The <u>agenda</u> was adopted.

Agenda item 2: UNEA-6 assessment and lessons learned.

- 3. The Secretariat presented a revised version of the <u>draft paper</u> outlining observations, lessons learned, and recommendations from the meetings of the sixth session of the United Nations Environment Assembly (UNEA-6), held from 26 February to 1 March 2024, and the sixth meeting of the Open-ended Committee of Permanent Representatives (OECPR-6), held from 19 to 23 February 2024.
- 4. The presentation was followed by an update on the outcomes of an informal exchange held on 4 June among delegations on the lessons learned from UNEA-6. The informal exchange took place with a view to identify the key lessons learned that find consensus amongst the membership, including on how to ensure the best possible use of the intersessional period, as a basis for a possible joint recommendation to the CPR.
- 5. The update was followed by an interactive discussion.
- 6. The Committee agreed that the informal exchange on the lessons learned from UNEA-6 should continue, with a view to reaching consensus on key recommendations, for further consideration and finalization at the 11th annual subcommittee meeting of the CPR to be held from 8 to 12 July 2024, for final adoption at the CPR at its 167th meeting in September 2024.
- 7. The Committee further agreed that the next opportunity to continue the informal exchange would take place on Monday 10 June 2024 from 15:00 to 17:00 (GMT+3).

Agenda item 3: Recommendations from the subcommittee meetings for consideration at the upcoming CPR quarterly meeting.

8. The Secretariat introduced the <u>draft report of the subcommittee of the CPR</u>, covering the meetings of the subcommittee held since the 165th meeting of the CPR, held on 25 January 2024.
