
Information sheet: One Health Seminar for the European Region

Vienna, 11 – 13 June 2024

Venue: University of Veterinary Medicine, Vienna

Language

The meeting will be carried out in **English** with simultaneous interpretation to **Russian**.

Meals

WOAH will cover coffee/tea breaks, lunches, and 1 gala dinner for all participants. Austria will host a Gala dinner for all participants.

Any meal not foreseen in the programme shall be covered by the participants themselves.

Participants will have to pay any additional costs for goods or services not directly covered by the organisers.

Insurance

Participants themselves are responsible for arranging international insurance (life/medical/travel), or for costs resulting from any illness, accident and/or loss which may occur during travel and/or training attendance.

Public transport in Vienna

Public transport in Vienna is well developed and very reasonably priced (e.g a yearly ticket costs 365 EUR!) and operates almost 20 hours a day. It is run by the "Wiener Linien". Operating hours:

- Underground trains run daily from around 5 a.m. to around midnight
- Trams and buses usually end their service a little earlier
- Detailed information can be found under Timetables, Network maps Wiener Linien
- The Vienna underground lines operate 24 hours a day on Friday nights, Saturday nights and the nights before public holidays. Trains run at 15-minute intervals.
- The night buses run daily from approx. 0.30 5.00 a.m. at 30-minute intervals. The timetables for the Nightline can be found at **Timetables**, **Network maps Wiener Linien**
- You can use the night buses and the S-Bahn in the Vienna city area with all **Wiener Linien** tickets and, of course, with the **Vienna City Card**.

We suggest using **google maps** for planning your arrival/departure. <u>Venue</u>: University of Veterinary Medicine; Veterinärplatz 1, 1210 Vienna

Airport transfers to the hotels and Directions to the University of Veterinary Medicine, Vienna

Please check with your organisation whether an airport transfer will be booked for you centrally or whether you are entitled/requested to book your own airport transfer/taxi or take public transport to get to your hotel!

• from Vienna International Airport (Schwechat) to the venue

A bus (Vienna Airport Lines, Postbus) goes from Vienna International Airport straight to Wien Donauzentrum (via Vienna International Center VIC)/U1 station Kagran (duration of the journey approximately 40 minutes). Change to bus 27A heading to Hermann-Gebauer-Straße and get off at Veterinärmedizinische Universität.

• from Westbahnhof train station:

U6 heading to Floridsdorf, get off at Floridsdorf, change to tram 26 heading to Kagran and get off at Josef-Baumann-Gasse/Veterinärmedizinische Universität

or change to tram 25 heading to Aspern, Oberdorfstraße and get off at Josef-Baumann-Gasse.

• from Wien Hauptbahnhof (Main train station):

U1 heading to Leopoldau, get off at Kagraner Platz, change to tram 26 heading to Strebersdorf and get off at Josef-Baumann-Gasse/Veterinärmedizinische Universität.

Another alternative:

U1 heading to Leopoldau, get off at Kagran, change to bus 27A heading to Hermann-Gebauer-Straße and get off at Veterinärmedizinische Universität

or change to tram 25 heading to Floridsdorf and get off at Josef-Baumann-Gasse.

• by rapid transit system:


S1 (heading to Gänserndorf), S2 (heading to Mistelbach), S3 (heading to Hollabrunn), S15 (heading to Floridsdorf) get off at Floridsdorf, change to tram 26 heading to Kagran and get off at Josef-Baumann-Gasse/Veterinärmedizinische Universität

or change to tram 25 heading to Aspern, Oberdorfstraße and get off at Josef-Baumann-Gasse.

Vienna in numbers

Area: 415 km² Districts: 23 Population: 2.0 million Elevation: 171 m (Stephansplatz) Language: German Currency: Euro

Time zone

Vienna is in the Central European time zone (CET = GMT / UCT + 1). Daylight saving time applies from the last Sunday in March to the last Sunday in October (CEST).

Electricity

The typical mains voltage for households (as well as hotels) in Vienna is 230 volts (alternating current)

Telephone

The telephone prefix for calling Vienna from other countries is: + 43 1

Language

German is spoken in Austria, and the most commonly spoken foreign language is English.

Units of measure

The metric system is used in Austria. The most important weights and measures:

Metric = Great Britain / USA

1 gram (g) = 0.0353 ounces 1 kilo(gram) (kg) = 2.204 pounds 1 centimeter (cm) = 0.393 inches 1 meter (m) = 3.281 feet / 1.093 yards 1 kilometer (km) = 0.621 miles

Great Britain / USA = Metric

1 US pint (pt) = 0.473 liters 1 UK pint (pt) = 0.568 liters 1 US gallon (gal) = 3.785 liters 1 UK gallon (gal) = 4.456 liters

Climate and temperature

Vienna has a mild continental climate. Even if the occasional winter day is icy and some days in high summer can bring sweltering heat to the palaces of the old city, most days of the year the weather matches the residents of the city: friendly, mild and moderate in every respect ...
