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ANNOTATED PROVISIONAL AGENDA

1. Opening of the meeting and adoption of the agenda.

H. E. Mr. Arnaud Suquet, Vice Chair of the Committee of Permanent Representatives (CPR), Ambassador of France to the Republic of Kenya and Permanent Representative to the United Nations Environment Programme, will open and chair the meeting.

2. Review of UNEP thematic programmes.

Following the Committee's demand for early and strategic planning in the performance of its oversight function vis-à-vis the Programme of Work, presentations will be delivered to the subcommittee on all 13 thematic programmes between 18 April and 3 December 2024. Under this item, the Secretariat will present an overview of the three following thematic programmes:

1) **“Mainstreaming Biodiversity and Ecosystem Services across Sectors and Systems”** which aims at integrating biodiversity into public and private sector planning, decision-making and in development to maximize benefits and avoid negative impacts on nature;

2) **“Governance and Accountability for Biodiversity”**, which focuses on accelerating the delivery of the Kunming-Montreal Global Biodiversity Framework and other biodiversity related commitments through improved governance, transparency and accountability to deliver on national and international commitments for biodiversity; and

3) **“Science for Policy and Action”**, which aims at ensuring that policymaking and stakeholder actions are informed by environmental data and information.

The Committee will be invited to take note of the briefings and engage in an exchange of views with the Committee Members and the Secretariat.

3. Other matters.

The meeting will consider any other matters related to its work.

4. Closing of the meeting.
