EAS PROJECT OBJECTIVE AND SCOPE

Objective: Help countries fast-track readiness and early actions to implement the GBF through updated NBSAPs, including national biodiversity targets, monitoring, policy, and finance frameworks

Scope: 138 countries – LDCs, SIDs (69 UNEP-supported and 69 UNDP-supported)


Funding Source: Global Environment Facility, jointly implemented by UNEP and UNDP in collaboration with SCBD

Focus: Identifying and assessing gaps, so that Parties are ready to take action to implement the GBF


Duration: through February 2025





National Target Assessment

Analysis of Targets established by Parties aligned with the Kunming-Montreal Global Biodiversity Framework

CBD/SBI/5/2/Add.2

- Alignment with GBF Goals and Targets
 - Majority of Parties addressed all GBF targets through their national targets
 - National targets linked with all GBF goals
- Description of national target included in half of targets submitted
- GBF Section C issues addressed in 1/3 of targets
- Component, complementary or national indicators included by half of Parties
- Little information on contributions of non-State actors
