Guiding Principles of the UNSG's CETM Panel

Principle 1: Human rights must be at the core of all mineral value chains. (AR2, 4)

Principle 2: The integrity of the planet, its environment and biodiversity must be safeguarded. (AR, 2, 3, 4, 5)

Principle 3: Justice and equity must underpin mineral value chains. (AR1, 3, 4)

Principle 4: Development must be fostered through benefit sharing, value addition and economic diversification. (AR1)

Principle 5: Investments, finance and trade must be responsible and fair. (AR1, 2)

Principle 6: Transparency, accountability and anti-corruption measures are necessary to ensure good governance. (AR2)

Principle 7: Multilateral and international cooperation must underpin global action and promote peace and security. (All ARs)
