JHR Position on the UNEA-7 Ministerial Declaration:

Key Messages from JHR:

- Promoting Synergies for Resilient Solutions: Strengthen cross-convention collaboration under the Rio Conventions to address environmental challenges holistically.
- Advancing Climate Finance: Deliver on the \$300 billion annual NCQG with a clear mechanism for supporting vulnerable regions.
- **Safeguarding Biodiversity:** Establish dedicated financial mechanisms to halt biodiversity loss and restore ecosystems.

JHR's Call to Action:

- **Empower the Media and Citizen Journalism:** Recognize journalism and citizen-led reporting as essential for amplifying environmental issues, fostering accountability, and driving public engagement.
- **Promote Citizen Science:** Encourage public participation in data collection and environmental monitoring to drive community engagement and policy solutions.
- **Ensure Access to Information:** Promote open access to environmental data for informed civic participation and oversight.
- **Champion Digital Solutions:** Support emerging technologies, including remote sensing and AI, for sustainable land management and monitoring.
