- 9 seats, one per major group + 1
- 3mn per intervention at the discretion of the Chair
- Interventions by <u>accredited organizations</u> <u>only</u>

Ministerial roundtables

- Access limited only with special badges
- 9 seats, one per major group
- Interventions at the discretion of the Chair or Facilitator
- Interventions by <u>accredited organizations</u> <u>only</u>
