# **Status of the Environment Fund and other sources of funding of the United Nations Environment Programme**

**Report by the Executive Director<sup>1</sup>** 

Summary

The present note, submitted pursuant to paragraph 14 of Governing Council decision 26/9, provides information on the status of the Environment Fund and other sources of funding for the United Nations Environment Programme for the biennium 2012–2013.

It should be noted that these figures are preliminary and further adjustments may occur. The final financial statements will be issued in March 2013 by the United Nations Office at Nairobi and thereafter audited by United Nations Board of Auditors.

### The financial framework of UNEP

1. **Table 1** below presents the financial framework of UNEP consisting of the GC.26 approved total biennial budget and the actual expenditures as at 31 December 2012 from all sources funds which directly support UNEP Programme of Work namely Environment Fund, Trust Funds and Earmarked Contributions, Programme Support Cost and Regular Budget. The resources of Conventions, Protocols, Regional Seas Action Plans, GEF and the Multilateral Fund are not included in the table.

2. The total approved budget for the biennium 2012-2013 was US\$ 474.0 as shown in **Table 1** and a total of US\$ 259.8 million was allotted in 2012 from all sources of funds for programme implementation. Expenditures recorded in 2012 against all sources of funds amounted to US\$ 222.8 million or 85% of the allotment. These figures are preliminary and further adjustments may occur as the final financial statements for 2012 will not be issued until March 2013.

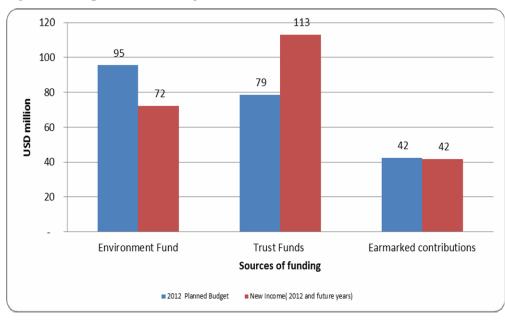

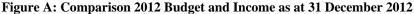

3. For 2012-2013 the GC 26 approved an Environment Fund budget of 191 million with a ceiling of US\$122.3 million for posts costs. Actual post costs for 2012 are estimated at US\$ 55 million which is within the target.

### I. Contribution analysis

4. At 31 December 2012, income from contributions directly supporting the Environment Fund for 2012 amounted to US\$ 71.6 million which, when added to USD 13.3 million carry over from the previous biennium, is US\$ 10.6 million less than the US\$ 95.5 million GC approved budget. Income received from Trust Funds directly supporting UNEP's POW total US\$ 113 million, US\$ 34 million more than the budget estimate of US\$ 79 million. Income received from Earmarked Contributions supporting UNEP's POW total US\$ 42 million, equal to the 2012 budget estimate.





### II. Environment Fund

The Governing Council at its 26th session approved appropriations of US\$ 191 million for the 2012-2013 Environment Fund Programme and Biennial Support Budget (GC Decision 26/9), equal to US\$ 95.5 million for each year of the biennium. **Table 2** below shows that contributions received in 2012 amount to US\$ 71.58 million of which US\$ 71.41 million have been paid and US\$ 0.17 million were unpaid pledges that are expected to be paid in 2013. Details of contributions are provided in Annex I and II.

### **III.** Budget performance

#### A. Environment Fund

5. Taking into account the shortfall in contributions received in 2012 as compared to budget, the Executive Director issued allocations in 2012 of US\$ 78.5 million of which US\$ 67.5 million was for Environment Fund Programme activities, US\$ 7.8 million for the Environment Fund Biennial Support Budget and US\$ 3.2 million for Fund Programme Reserve.

6. Expenditure in 2012 was US\$72.8 million against the US\$ 78.5 million allocation, giving a 92.7% fund utilization rate. **Table 3** below shows the approved budget, allocations and expenditures by sub-programmes as at 31 December 2012.

#### **Trust Funds and Earmarked Contributions**

7. The estimated resources for Trust Funds and Earmarked Contributions for the biennium 2012-2013 approved by UNEP GC 26/9 amounted to US\$ 242.1 million, of which US\$ 157.2 million is for trust funds and US\$ 84.9 million for earmarked contributions. Expenditure for the trust funds and earmarked contributions directly supporting the UNEP Programme of Work as at 31 December 2012 was US\$ 129.6 million, equivalent to 80.5% of the 2012 allotted resources of US\$ 161 million as noted in Table 4 below.

### **B.** Support Account for Trust Funds and Earmarked Contributions

8. The Programme Support Account income is generated from the administrative overhead charged to trust funds and earmarked contributions based on their actual expenditures, in accordance with the UN Regulations and Rules. The rationale behind this provision is to ensure that activities financed through extra-budgetary resources (i.e. Trust Funds and Earmarked Contributions) do not create any additional burden to the UN Regular Budget, or in the case of UNEP, the Environment Fund budget which is UNEP's core budget. For UNEP administered conventions, 67% of the Programme Support Account for Trust Funds and Earmarked Contributions resources are allocated towards their Secretariats for the provision of fund management and administrative services. The balance of the Programme Support Account budget covers the administrative costs of managing Trust Funds and Earmarked Contributions incurred by UNEP and UNON.

9. **Table 5** below shows total projected income from programme support resources for the biennium 2012-2013 is US\$ 28.2 million. Expenditure to 31 December 2012 was US\$ 13.6 million against an allotment of US\$ 14.2 million, resulting in unspent balance of US\$ 0.6 million.

### C. Regular Budget

10. The Regular Budget of the United Nations provides support to the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) in line with the General Assembly resolution 2997 (XXVII). When it established UNEP, the Assembly decided that "the costs of servicing the Governing Council and providing the small secretariat... shall be borne by the Regular Budget of the United Nations".

11. For the biennium 2012-2013, the total estimated allocations to UNEP from the Regular Budget (excluding the allocation for United Nations Scientific Committee on the Effects of Atomic Radiation (UNSCEAR)) are US\$12.8 million, **Table 6** below shows that the 2012 expenditures of US\$ 6.8 million exceed the allotment by US\$ 0.7 million. This over-expenditure occurred on the staff
