

Main preparatory events of member states

- Regular Meetings of the Committee of Permanent Representatives (public)
- Regular Bureaus' meetings (closed or partly closed)
- Joint meetings of CPR and UNEA Bureaus (March and September 2018), partly public
- Annual Subcommittee meeting (late October or early December), public
- Open Ended CPR (2019, before or back to back with the 2019 Assembly), public
- HLPF meeting (June), public
- Regional preparatory meetings:
 - AMCEN special session (tbc, maybe during CBD COP in Egypt)
 - Asia Pacific Ministerial Forum on the Environment (November)
 - Other regional meetings (tbc)
 - PAGE meeting South Africa (September)

- UNEA Bureau to decide
- Options:
 - Restart negotiations on policy document now
 - Restart negotiations on policy document at a later stage
 - Only adjust Rule 70
 - Concentrate on improving practices in line with "The Future We Want"
