





POW Achievement: 2016-2017 Across Sub-Programmes





IMPACT LIKELIHOOD: Evaluation findings for 2016-2017





SUSTAINABILITY: Evaluation findings by sustainability of outcomes (2014-2017)
















Countries that are addressing ocean pollution as a result of UN Environment Programme contribution



- Policy advice from UN environment taken up in the UN family...






