

Brief information of WOD 2018

KIRIBATI

Kiribati through the Environment and Conservation Division (ECD) – MELAD, undertook various awareness activities to celebrate and commemorate the World Ozone Day 2018. Activities are as follows:

1. School visit carried out on South Tarawa starting from 10 – 12 September 2018. There were 4 high school visits and ODS awareness materials such as pamphlets and posters were disseminated to students and teachers during the visit;
2. The WOD 2018 radio spot was aired 1 week before 16 September 2018. This was intended to inform the public about the 2018 WOD activities and the purpose of such celebration;
3. Display of the 2018 World Ozone Day banner at the Public area for 1 week;
4. Consultation to ODS key stakeholders on South Tarawa including private sectors and government offices;
5. Drama roadshow was carried out in South Tarawa on 14 September 2018. The goal of the roadshow was to deliver key messages of the importance of ozone layer, ODS, ozone layer depletion, impacts of ozone layer depletion, global responses and Kiribati obligation under the Montreal Protocol to the public; and
6. The development of awareness materials such as:
 - 2018 WOD awareness t-shirts worn by the drama group during the roadshow.
 - 2018 awareness local-hats which will be given away during the Environment Week.
