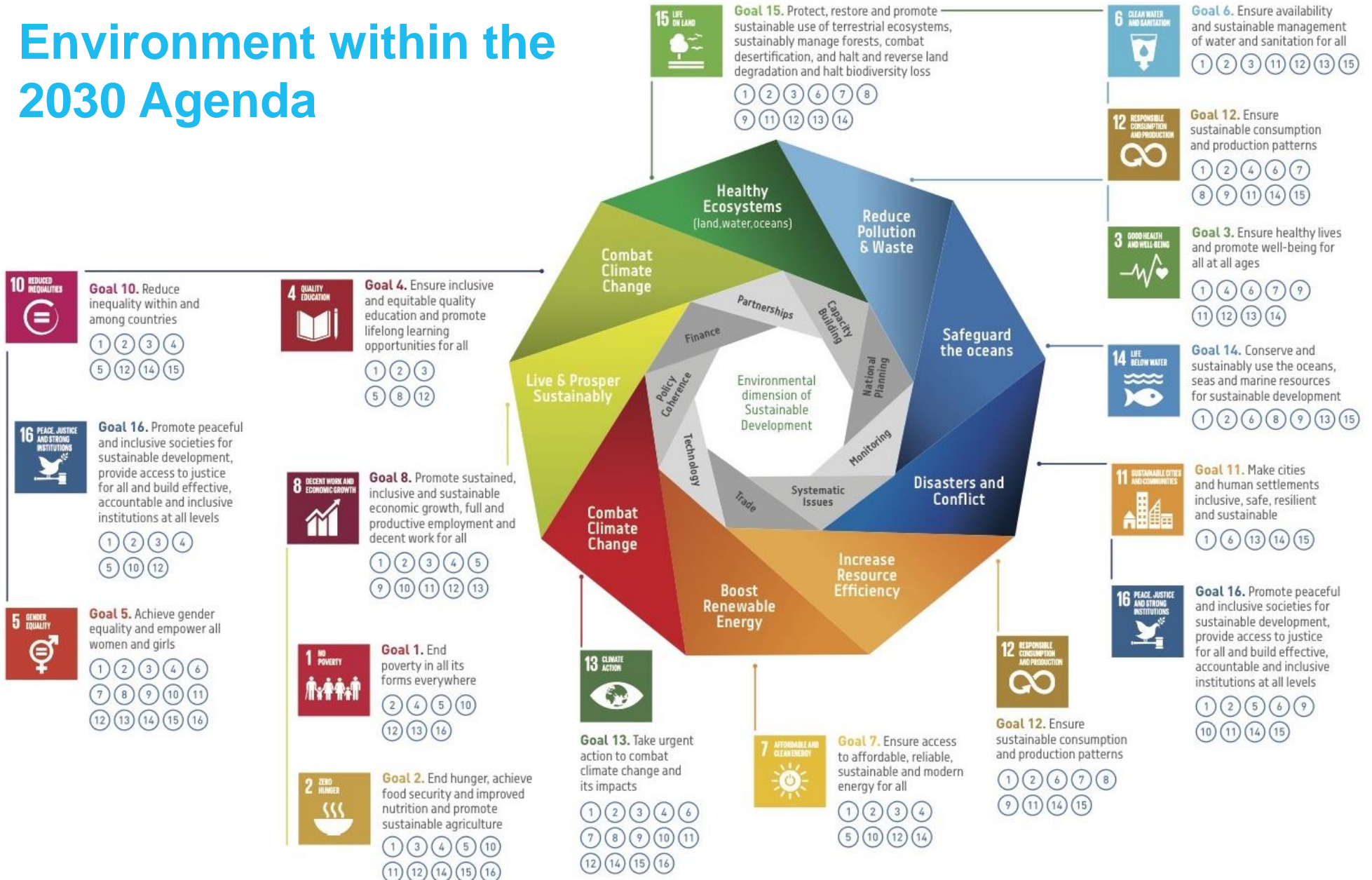

UN Environment Programme as an integral part of the UN Development System

- Delivery of our environment mandate within the 2030 Agenda
 - Support to a new generation of UN Country Teams
 - Advice and policy guidance on integration of environmental sustainability in close cooperation with partners
 - Stronger coordination of global environmental policies and strategies
- ➔ Amplify UN Environment Programme's results and impact
- ➔ Better support Member States



Leveraging Core Strengths of UNEP:

New Resident Coordinator System

UN Development Assistance Frameworks → UN Sustainable Development Cooperation Frameworks

- Alignment with new Management Accountability Framework (MAF)
- Funding:
 - Funding Compact
 - 1% Coordination Levy
 - UN Development System Cost-sharing
 - 15% of non-core resources to joint UN Activities
- Support of strengthened pool of Resident Coordinators
 - Development of Talent and Leadership Strategy

- Review of regional and country presence strategies
- Development of UNEP-“menu of services” offered to UN Country Teams and Resident Coordinators
- Aligning programme and project planning to new Cooperation Frameworks
- Review of monitoring policy (UN INFO)
- Adaptation of Knowledge Management Approach
- Review of Resource Mobilization Strategy
- Strengthening staff capacities on SDGs & Cooperation Frameworks
 - Development of renewed Human Resource Strategy
- Embedding the principles of the System-Wide Strategic Document into UNEP’s next Medium Term Strategy
- Improvement of SDG data, data collection and monitoring
- Improvement of monitoring and reporting system

- Engage in new Regional Collaboration Platforms
- Engage in new regional knowledge management hubs

- Signing the Mutual Recognition Statement of UNDS
