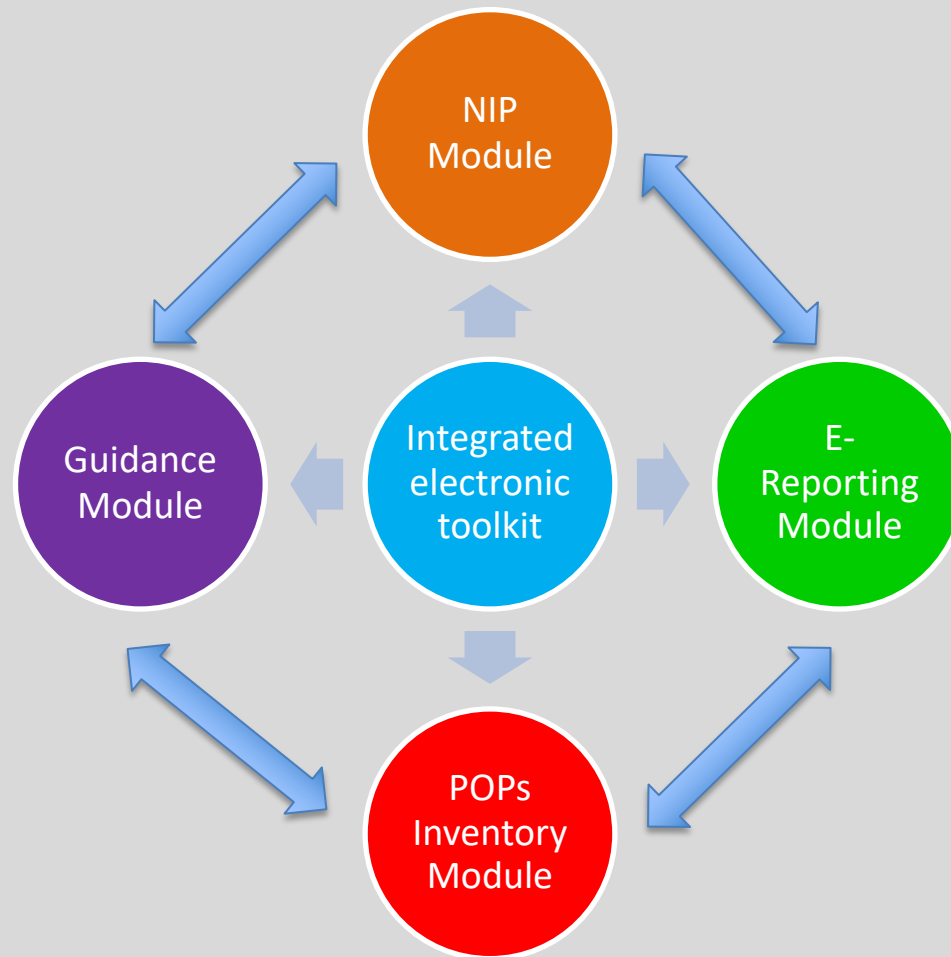

Interconnects with the NIP Module

## E-Reporting Module

Allows to retrieve/transfer data/information from/to NIP Module

Predefines data/information reported previously
