-Pursuant to paragraph 10(d) of UNEA resolution 3/7, and the outcome document of AHEG-3 held in November 2019, the Chair of AHEG sent a letter on 11 December 2019, inviting member States and stakeholders to provide submissions of potential response options through the AHEG web portal.

-By the deadline of 15 August 2020, the Secretariat has received 11 submissions from member States and Specialized Agencies, and 4 submissions from Major Groups and Stakeholders (CIEL, EIA and Gaia; Indian Water Foundation; WWF; and Association Welfare).
