#### Agenda Item 7(a): Structure of UNEA-5

Following the consideration of the timing and format of the fifth session of the UN Environment Assembly in view of COVID-19 by the [UNEA Bureau](#) at its meeting on 8 October, the UNEA Bureau decided to support the [proposal by the UNEA President](#) to adopt a “two-step” approach that will allow for the convening UNEA-5 in February 2021 at the dates previously agreed in a virtual format with a revised and streamlined agenda. The UNEA Bureau also requested the Secretariat to propose a structure for a virtual session of UNEA-5 in February 2021 for consideration at the 7<sup>th</sup> annual subcommittee and thereafter, on the basis of feedback from Member States, to the next meeting of the Joint Bureaux of UNEA and of the CPR, scheduled for 1 December 2020.

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## DRAFT STRUCTURE FOR THE VIRTUAL SESSION OF UNEA-5

This note outlines a revised draft structure for the virtual session of UNEA-5 to be held from 22 to 23/24 February 2021 and a proposed distribution of agenda items between the virtual and resumed session of UNEA-5 in February 2022.

In particular the Secretariat proposes that the virtual session of UNEA-5 consists of one opening plenary which will fulfill the functions outlined in the structure contained in this document, one high level opening, one multi-stakeholder dialogue, one leadership dialogue and one adjournment and wrap-up plenary.

The high-level opening will consist of a structured virtual event which will offer the opportunity for the Assembly to hear messages by dignitaries from the host country and a regionally balanced group of Heads of State and government. It will also offer the opportunity for the Secretary-General of the United Nations to address the Assembly.

The proposed theme of the Leadership Dialogue is “Strengthening UNEP to help us build back better”. In order to allow for maximum participation, interactivity and constructive engagement the Secretariat proposes that the dialogue be organized across 4 groups with 2 different timeslots in order to facilitate both the connection and the interaction amongst Ministers and high-level representatives. Each group will have as per practice a moderator.

The Multi-Stakeholder Dialogue, organized by Major Groups and Stakeholders, provides an opportunity for Major Groups and Stakeholders to engage in a dialogue with Government and share views and experiences relevant to the theme of the Assembly. This dialogue is open to interested Ministers and high-level representatives.

With regards to the timing of the adjournment wrap-up plenary the Secretariat, proposes two possible options and times, Tuesday 23 February 2021 from 17:00 - 19:00 or Wednesday 24 February 2021 from 14:00 -16:00, for consideration.

Member States are invited to consider the draft provisional agenda and proposed structure for the virtual session of UNEA-5 and provide feedback and guidance with a view to facilitate further consideration of this matter at the next meeting of the Joint Bureaux of UNEA and of the CPR, scheduled for 1 December 2020.
