

**Report - OARE/Research4Life Exhibition
United Nations Environment Assembly
Nairobi, Kenya, 11-15 March 2019**

1. Introduction

This report summarizes the activities of the OARE/Research4Life exhibition during the United Nations Environment Assembly on 11-15 March 2019 in Nairobi, Kenya.

2. Workshop Objectives

The overall objective of this exhibition was to take the opportunity of the large participation in the United Nations Environment Assembly to popularize and vulgarize the Research4Life programmes with a special focus on OARE.

The Specific objectives for exhibition were:

1. To introduce visitors to OARE and other R4L programmes
2. To introduce visitors to eligible countries
3. To take the visitors through the registration process
4. To give visitors an overview of scientific e-resources available through the Research4Life platforms.

3. Expected Outputs

At the end of the workshop, participants were expected to:

1. Be aware of Research4Life programmes;
2. Establish whether their countries or institutions were eligible for access to Research4Life resources
3. Register for Research4Life through their institutions
4. Use Research4Life resources.

4. Exhibition Delivery

The exhibitors used a variety of methods during the exhibition, including oral presentations, live demonstrations on the OARE platform, and video presentations playing on a TV screen and featuring the objective, depth and impact of Research4Life resources.

The exhibition booth was manned over the whole duration of UNEA by the UNEP library team comprised of Samuel Opiyo, Stella Munene and Virginia Gitari.

5. Participation

The exhibition registered a total of 67 participants from 51 institutions.
