


SwitchMed I Programme

SwitchMed is an EU-funded initiative fostering Sustainable Consumption and Production (SCP) patterns in eight Southern Mediterranean countries (Algeria, Egypt, Israel, Jordan, Lebanon, Morocco, Palestine and Tunisia). SwitchMed directly supports the reinforcement of an enabling policy environment, the practices by private sector and facilitation of experience-sharing among stakeholders. It further aims at stimulating the creation of greener business opportunities and decent employment, while reducing the environmental footprint of consumption and production activities. Different measures will help to make the circular economy model the mainstream business model in the Southern Mediterranean region.

The different components and activities of the SwitchMed programme concentrate on:

- · mainstreaming SCP into national policy;
- building and strengthening capacities of businesses, business support organizations, resource efficiency and cleaner production service providers and government authorities through trainings, coaching and technical assistance;
- raising awareness and knowledge in the private and public sector in order to ensure ownership of the action and help build a community of practice on SCP.


The first phase of SwitchMed (2013-2018) was divided in three components addressing different parts of the transition process to Sustainable Consumption and Production – Sustainable Development Goal-SDG12:

- Policy: development of a regional SCP action plan (SCP-NAP) for the Mediterraneanand eight SCP national action plans;
- Demonstration activities: link the policy component and the private sector(cleaner production);
- Networking and communication: exchange of good practices, joint learningand scaling up;

The United Nations Environment Program's mandate during phase I was to:

- provide advisory services and technical support to the project countries in the development of their Sustainable Consumption and Production National Action Plans;
- support a variety of demonstration projects in Egypt, Israel, Jordan and Palestine.

Sustainable Consumption and Production National Action Plans (SCP-NAPs):

- Eight national action plans have been developed through multi-stakeholder processes (government, civil society, private sector, media, academia, international community) and validated during technical national workshops;
- More than 25 multi-stakeholder national workshops and roundtables organized with over 1,500 participants;
- The SCP-NAPs allow the project countries to fulfill SDG indicator 12.1 of the Agenda 2030;
