Introduction

1. In accordance with the UN Environment/Mediterranean Action Plan Programme of Work 2016-2017 adopted by COP 19, Athens, Greece, 9-12 February 2016, the Secretariat is organizing the meeting of the MED POL Focal Points (FP) from 29-31 May 2017, at the Food and Agriculture Organization Headquarters in Rome, Italy.

- 2. The main objectives of the meeting are to:
 - 1. Review the activities carried out during the 2016-2017 biennium and the implementation of the three pollution related Protocols under the MED POL Programme responsibility with a particular focus on NAPs and IMAP implementation.
 - 2. Review a number of important documents and address thematic issues related to key aspects of the MED POL mandate related to guidelines, assessment, possible new regional or updated measures etc.
 - 3. Discuss and agree upon the activities to be implemented during the next biennium for inclusion in the MAP Programme of Work 2018-2019.

The following annotations to the Provisional Agenda were prepared by the Secretariat to assist the meeting in its deliberations.

Provisional Annotated Agenda

Agenda item 1: Opening of the Meeting

3. The Meeting will be opened at 09.30 on 29 May 2017 by the Deputy Coordinator of UN Environment/Mediterranean Action Plan – Barcelona Convention Secretariat and the representative of the host country.

Agenda items 2 and 3: Election of Officers, Adoption of the Agenda and Organization of Work UNEP(DEPI)/MED WG.439/1; UNEP(DEPI)/MED WG.439/2; UNEP(DEPI)/MED WG.439/Inf.1

a) Rules of Procedure

4. The rules of procedure for meetings and conferences of the Contracting Parties to the Convention for the Protection of the Marine Environment and the Coastal Region of the Mediterranean and its Protocols will apply mutatis mutandis to the present meeting (UNEP/IG.43/6, Annex XI).

b) Election of Officers

5. Subject to Rule 20 of the rules of procedure mentioned at para. 2(a), the Meeting of the MED POL Focal Points will elect from among the representatives of the Contracting Parties, a President, three Vice-Presidents and a Rapporteur.

c) Adoption of the Provisional Agenda

6. Subject to Rule 14 of the rules of procedure mentioned at para. 2(a), the proposed agenda appearing in document UNEP(DEPI)/MED WG.439/1 and annotated in the present document (UNEP (DEPI)/MED WG.439/2) will be reviewed and proposed for adoption by the meeting including the timetable contained in the Annex to the present document.

d) Organization of Work

7. Sessions are scheduled every day from 09:30-12:30 and 14:30-17:30. It is expected that the MED POL Focal Points will address all items of the Agenda during its three days meeting. The meeting is planned to be held in Plenary Session. The meeting may consider establishing small working groups to address during breaks specific issues as appropriate for final review by the Plenary Session.

8. Simultaneous interpretation in English and French will be available for all sessions. All documentation will be in English and French. As per practice, pre-session documentation will not be distributed on paper. Participants are encouraged to download the documentation on their computers in advance of the session.

9. The participants will be invited to review and adopt the meeting conclusions and recommendations, amended as appropriate, drafted by the Rapporteur. The report of the meeting will be prepared and circulated for adoption after the meeting.

10. It is envisaged to close the meeting at 17:30 on 31 May 2017.

The meeting is expected to review the proposed draft and provide feedback as appropriate with the view to have the Revised Reporting Format finalized by the Secretariat and submitted to MAP Focal Points meeting.

Under this agenda item, the Secretariat will introduce document UNEP(DEPI)/MED WG.439/4, comprising a gap analysis of existing regional measures related to pollution and litter, and identifying main areas, where existing measures appear not sufficient to achieve Good Environmental Status of the Mediterranean Sea. The document also presents the main outcomes of the Assessment of Annexes to the Pollution-related Protocols in light of recent developments at regional and global level.

16. The Meeting is expected to review the document and provide feedback as appropriate with the view to have it finalized and submitted to the EcAp Coordination and MAP Focal Points meeting, as appropriate.

18. 19. The meeting is expected to review the proposed draft and provide feedback as appropriate with the view to have the Guidelines finalized and submitted to MAP Focal Points meeting and to COP 20 as appropriate.

20. 32.
