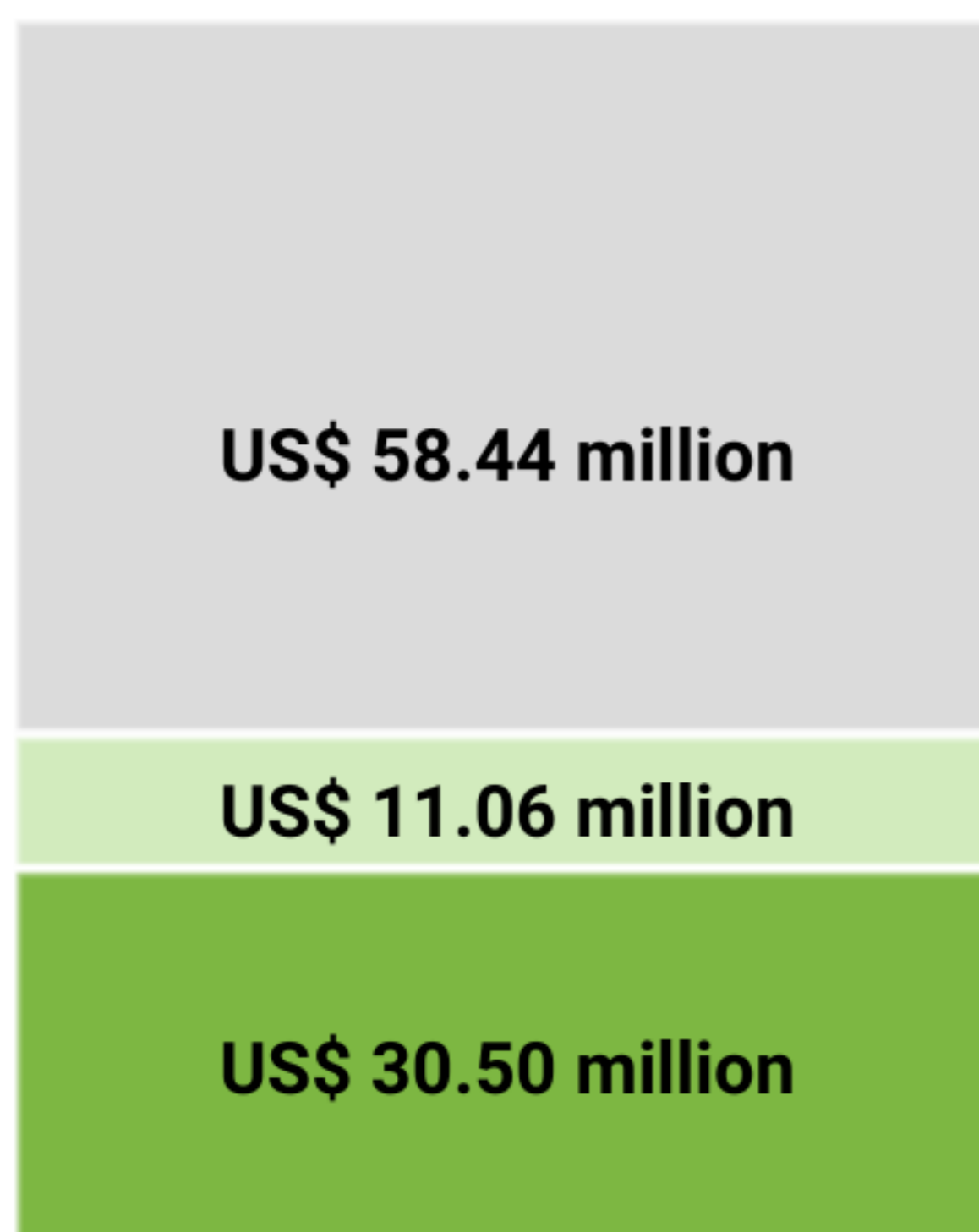

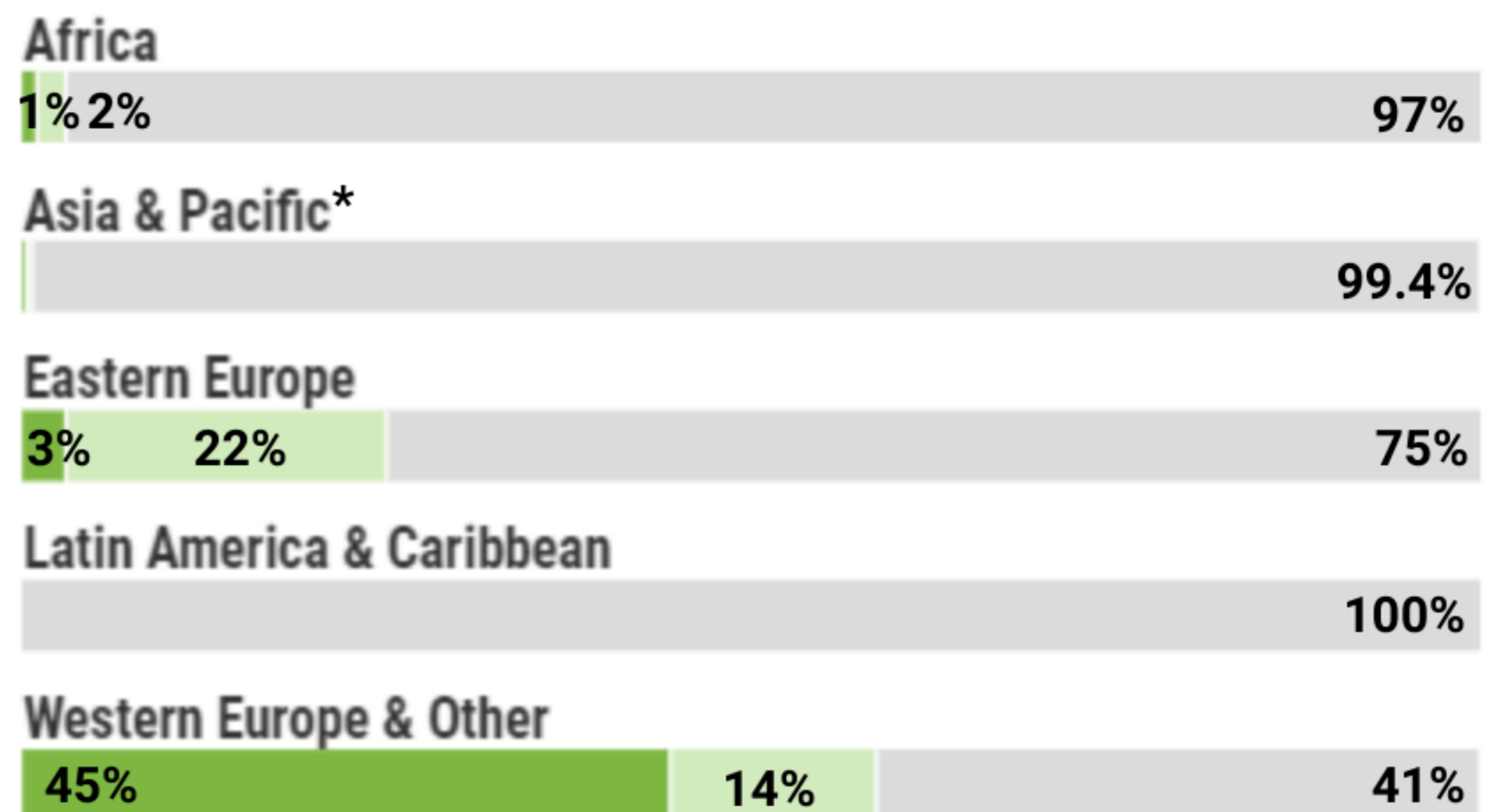

■ "fair share" contributions ■ Other contributions ■ Unfunded

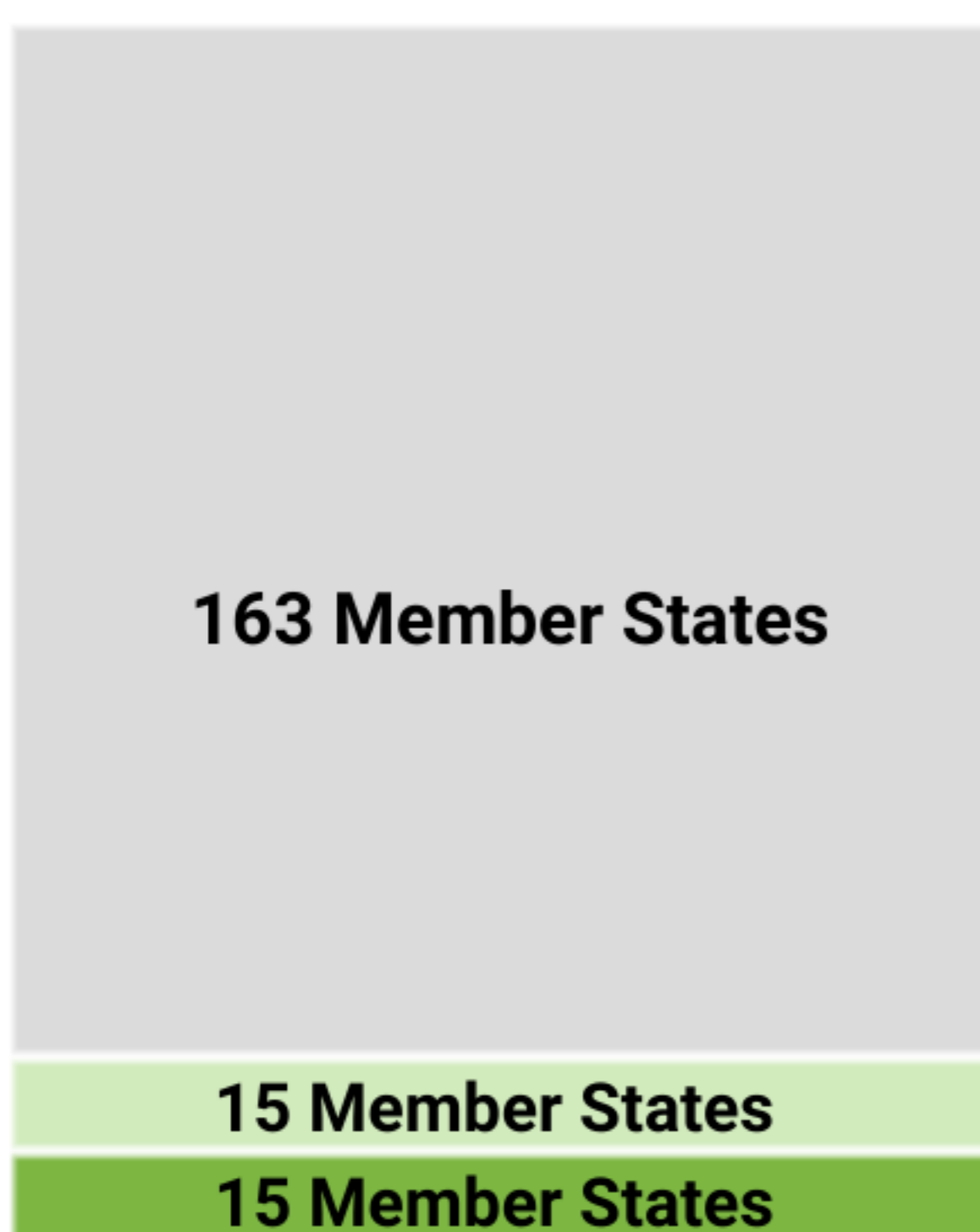
Regional statistics of contributions by category in percentage



*Asia & Pacific percentage of "fair share" contributions is 0.3% & other contributions is 0.4%

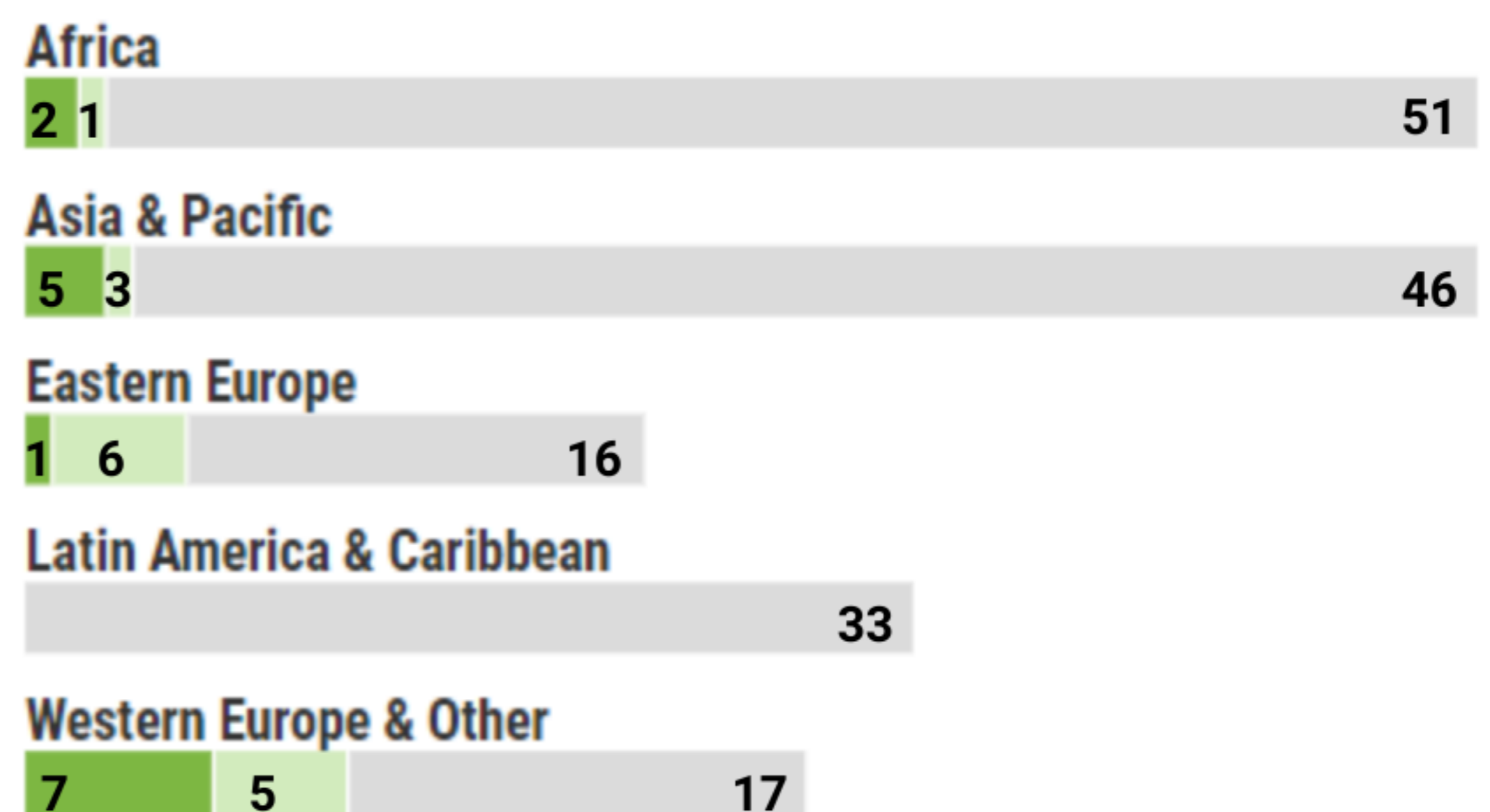
