First Meeting of RAC/ERS Focal Points Palermo, 9-11 September 1994

PROVISIONAL ANNOTATED AGENDA

Agenda item 1. Opening of the Meeting

The meeting will be opened on Friday 9 September 1994 at 9.00 a.m. by the Director of RAC/ERS, a representative of the UNEP/MAP and by local authorities.

Agenda item 2. Background and scope of the Meeting

The Director of RAC/ERS and the representative of UNEP/MAP will brief the participants on the MAP events which led to the creation of RAC/ERS and will explain the objectives as well as the expected outputs of the Meeting.

Agenda item 3. Election of officers

The Meeting will elect a Chairman, a vice Chairman and a rapporteur.

Agenda item 4. Adoption of the agenda and organization of work

The Meeting will examine document UNEP (OCA)/MED WG.83/1, Provisional Agenda, which will be revised as necessary, and adopted.

The rules of procedures adopted for meetings and conferences of the Contracting Parties to the Barcelona Convention will apply to this meeting.

The meeting will review and adopt the draft timetable attached as annex to the present document.

Simultaneous English-French translation will be available for the duration of the Meeting.

Agenda item 5. Programme and activities of RAC/ERS for 1994-1995

Under this Agenda item, before the presentation of the activities carried out by RAC/ERS, the Director of RAC/ERS will briefly present to the participants the history, the structure and the objectives of the Center, as well as the remote sensing techniques.

5.1 Activities of RAC/ERS in the Mediterranean Region

The Director of RAC/ERS will brief the Meeting on all activities carried out or being carried out by the Center within programmes other than MAP which are of relevance to MAP and whose results could be made available to MAP (document UNEP (OCA)/MED WG.83.3).

5.2 Activities of RAC/ERS in the framework of MAP

The Director of RAC/ERS will present to the Meeting the activities of RAC/ERS being carried out in the 1994-1995 biennium as part of MAP (document UNEP (OCA)/MED WG.83.3.

The presentation of the activities will be followed by a discussion.

Agenda item 6. Definition of potential areas of cooperation in the framework of MAP

Under this Agenda item, the RAC/ERS Focal Point may wish to introduce the national or international activities carried out by their countries relevant to RAC/ERS as well as their views on the potential areas of cooperation with RAC/ERS.

The Director of RAC/ERS and the UNEP/MAP representative will also present their views on the RAC/ERS experiences and expertise, structure and programmes which could usefully support and find synergies with the activities of MAP. A discussion will follow in order to identify specific MAP activity lines in which RAC/ERS will participate and contribute to, during the biennium 1996-1997.

Agenda item 7. Recommendation for activities of RAC/ERS for 1996-1997

As a follow up to the discussion and the conclusion of agenda item.6, the Meeting will agree on a set of recommendations relevant to the activities that RAC/ERS may carry out in the framework of MAP during the biennium 1996-1997. The draft recommendations prepared befor the Meeting (UNEP(OCA)/MED WG,83/4) will therefore be revised as a result of the discussions.

Agenda item 8. Other business

Other subject relevant to the RAC/ERS activities and programmes, which might be brought to the attention of the Meeting by the participants, will be discussed under this agenda item.

Agenda Item 9. Adoption of the report

A draft report of the meeting will be submitted to the participants for adoption.

Agenda item 10. Closure of the Meeting

The Meeting is expected to be closed on Sunday 11 September 1994 at 12,00 a.m.
