Annotated Agenda

Agenda item 1. Adoption of the Agenda

The provisional Agenda prepared by the Secretariat is contained in document: UNEP/BUR/27 - Working paper/1.

Agenda item 2. Progress report by the Co-ordinator

A written progress report covering the period 1 April - 31 August 1986 will be available in document "Working paper 3". The Co-ordinator will highlight the main developments and problems. The Bureau will be asked to take note of the report.

Agenda item 3. Draft of the programme Calendar 1986-1995

A new version of the programme Calendar 1986-1995 will be shown to the Bureau for comments on the presentation (working paper 4). The new version was circulated to the Contracting Parties on 20 August 1986 for their comments.

Agenda item 4. Alternative methods of calculating contributions to the Mediterranean Trust Fund (MTF)

As requested by the Bureau (Madrid, 20 March 86) the Secretariat circulated the suggestions for revising the apportionment of contributions to the MTF, to all Contracting Parties on 11 June 1986 for their views. The Bureau will be asked to review and take action on the proposal of the Secretariat contained in document: Working paper/5.

Agenda item 5. Meetings of the National Focal Points for the Blue Plan and the Priority Actions Programme in 1987

The Genoa Meeting (Sept. 1985) decided to convene two joint meetings of the NFPs for the BP and the PAP in 1986 and 1987. The joint meeting for 1986 was held in Athens, 28-30 April during which the question of convening separate meetings in 1987 for the NFPs of the BP and PAP was stressed by many participants. The Bureau will be asked to take action on the suggestion of the Secretariat contained in document: Working paper/6.

Agenda item 6. Opening of the Regional Activity Centre for Specially protected Areas, Salammbô, Tunis

During its last meeting (Madrid, March 86) the Bureau has designated H.E. Mr. Abdul-Hamid Munajid of Syria (Vice-President) to represent the Bureau at the official opening of the Centre. As institutional arrangements are to be completed and after consultation with the Director of the Centre, the Secretariat is proposing a new arrangement on the official opening of the Centre. The Bureau will be asked to take note of these arrangements contained in document: Working paper/7.

Agenda item 7. Date and place of the next meeting of the Bureau

The Bureau will be asked to take a decision on the date and place of the next meeting.

Agenda item 8. Other business

The Bureau may consider any other matters relevant to the implementation of the Mediterranean Action Plan programme.
