- 1 Download the <u>Marine Debris</u> <u>Tracker App</u> on your device.
- 2 Select 'Mississippi River Plastic Pollution/MRCTI' from the organization list.
- 3 Download the <u>Mississippi River</u> <u>Citizen Science Field Guide</u>. The guide provides detailed information on how to use the App, and how to collect data easily and safely.
 - 4 Select a data collection area. Any data collected is valuable, but we encourage you to choose a designated area on the map:

Rosedale | Greenville Google Maps will open, showing yellow squares so you can easily select a location.

5 Take a walk, collect data!

Follow the 3ft-wide path and record all items within it for 20 - 30 minutes. Do your best to track the debris you find within the marked square or just adjacent to it. We'll use this randomly sampled data for scientific analysis.
