FAITH-BASED ENGAGEMENT AT COP27

COP27 marks 30 years since the <u>UNFCCC</u> was created and 7 years since the <u>Paris Agreement</u> was adopted at COP21.

It is an opportunity for state actors to participate in the negotiation process for bold actions to address the climate crisis toward a sustainable future for generations to come. Non-state actors, including faith-based organizations, continue to advocate for ethical and moral underpinnings for climate action for the benefit of communities, livelihoods, and the environment.

At the 'African COP', as it has been dubbed, the theme 'Together for implementation' raises the expectation for African countries to advance the implementation of the National Determined Contributions (NDCs), including adaptation and mitigation efforts and delivery of finance to enhance implementation.

It is imperative to accelerate global climate action through emissions reduction, scaled-up adaptation efforts, and enhanced flows of appropriate finance, considering around half of the world's population is 'highly vulnerable to the impacts of climate change.


