The Convention


 Three main goals: the conservation of biological diversity (or biodiversity); the sustainable use of its components; and the fair and equitable sharing of benefits arising from genetic resources.

- Missing: regional component cross-border coordination to reflect on habitat integrity and address cross-border sectoral activities



Options for the way forward?

NBSAPs and Regional NBSAP would need to be "whole society NBSAP"

- Mainstreaming biodiversity into to key sectors
- Integrate development opportunities and challenges (infrastructure, energy, finance, fisheries, etc.)
- Starting a regional NBSAP initiative across the board – ensuring the NBSAPs are "talking" to each others
- supra-regional coordination (UNEP?)
- Feeding into the **GAWB /BiDi task force**?
