ANNOTATED PROVISIONAL AGENDA

Introduction

1. In consultation with the host country (Syria) and the members of the Bureau, it was decided that the meeting will be held in Damascus, Syria from 18-19 March 2002, at the Hotel CHAM PALACE (Tel. 00963 11 2232300, Fax: 00963 11 2212398).
2. The following annotations to the provisional agenda for the meeting were prepared by the Secretariat to assist the meeting in its deliberations.

Agenda item 1: Opening of the meeting

3. The meeting will be opened at 09:30 hrs on Monday, 18 March 2002, by the President of the Bureau, H.E. Mr Bernard Fautrier, Minister Plenipotentiary in charge of International Cooperation for the Environment and Development of Monaco.
4. It is expected that the Bureau will tackle all items of the Provisional Agenda during its one and half day meeting including the adoption of a list of decisions. It is envisaged to close the meeting of the Bureau at 12:30 hrs on 19 March 2002. The report of the meeting will be prepared at MEDU by the Secretariat and distributed to the members for their comments.
