
Virtual exhibition: Winners and finalists of #MakeMercuryHistory Photo Contest 2022

On 13 July 2023, the Partnership Area on Mercury Releases from Coal Combustion held its annual meeting in the margins of the MEC15 International Workshop, in Jakarta, Indonesia. The meeting discussed latest updates on the Minamata Convention and ongoing project works. A follow up discussion took place on 19 July.



Minamata Online: Mercury waste threshold On 5 July 2023, the co-chairs of the Minamata Convention expert group on mercury waste and the Convention Secretariat presented the report proposing the threshold on waste management to be considered at COP-5. Further details here.


