





UNEP Regional Foresight Workshop – Europe Warsaw, Poland, 24 – 25 October 2023

PARTICIPANT INFORMATION NOTE

1. Opening and Registration

The UNEP Regional Foresight Workshop – Europe will be held at the Copernican Revolution Lab in Copernicus Science Centre in Warsaw, Poland, from Tuesday, 24 October, to Wednesday, 25 October 2023.

Participant registration is open at 8:30 a.m. and the meeting will start at 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, 24 October 2023.

2. Venue

The meeting will be held at:

3. Working language

The meeting will be held in English.

4. Meeting Documents

Documents will be circulated to meeting participants via email within 1 week of the meeting. In order to minimize the environmental footprint of the meeting and in line with the UN policy towards greener meetings, participants are kindly reminded to bring their own copies of the meeting documents, or to use paperless versions, as there will be no hard copies of meeting documents made available on site during the meeting. WIFI access will also be provided.

5. General information on access to Warsaw

Most flights to Warsaw land at Chopin Airport (www.lotnisko-chopina.pl/en/index.html) about 10 km from the city centre. The second airport operating in Warsaw is Warsaw Modlin Airport (https://en.modlinairport.pl/), located around 35 km north-west from the city centre. Information on how to get from each airport to the venue is provided in the table below, including rates.

Bus/metro	Public transport, bus 175 from <i>Lotnisko</i> <i>Chopina - Przyloty 02</i> to <i>Uniwersytet 02</i> Runs every 15 min, the trip will take approx. 40 min + 10 min walk to the venue You will need a <i>Single-fare 75 minute</i> <i>ticket</i> for 4,40PLN, bought from a ticket machine near bus stop. Taxi	Chopin Airport recommends ELE Taxi , with taxi rank in front of the Terminal. It will take approx. 35 min, at the cost of approx. 50PLN during day and 75PLN at night. In Warsaw you can also use Uber , Bolt and FreeNow apps. Depending on chosen app and conditions the price should vary from 30 to 60PLN.	Warsaw Modlin Airport recommends OPTI TAXI and TAXI MODLIN . It will take approx. 50 min at the cost of 130 to 160PLN with OPTI TAXI and 250PLN during day and 280PLN at night with TAXI MODLIN . In Warsaw you can also use Uber , Bolt and FreeNow apps. Depending on chosen app	

6. Visa information

Citizens of EU countries can arrive in Poland on the basis of a valid identity card or passport. The document must be valid for at least the duration of the intended stay.

Participants from Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Montenegro, Georgia, North Macedonia, Moldova, Serbia and Ukraine need a biometric passport to enter Poland without a visa.

Participants from countries listed in **annex A** require "The Uniform Schengen Visa (C-type visa)" and are strongly advised to contact the nearest Polish diplomatic or consular mission **as soon as possible** in order to secure the required entry visa in a timely manner, prior to departure. **Please note that airline companies will not allow boarding in the absence of a valid visa**.

Before submitting a visa application, participants need to register with eConsulate.

To facilitate the issuance of visas, UNEP will issue **upon request** invitation letters to be attached to the visa applications.

8. Payment of the Daily Subsistence Allowance (DSA)

The relevant portion of DSA, taking also into account meals provided during the meeting, will be disbursed to funded participants via direct bank transfer following the meeting. Funded participants are kindly requested to bring their passports and boarding passes on the first day of the meeting. These will be photocopied and returned to participants during the meeting. It is advisable that participants have some cash at hand to cover expenses that may occur during their stay.

9. Official languages

The official language in Poland is Polish. However, English is widely spoken in Warsaw.

10. Weather and time zone information

In October, daily temperatures in Warsaw range between 8°C in the evenings and 13°C during the day. Current weather conditions can be found at: <u>https://worldweather.wmo.int/en/city.html?cityId=24</u>.

The time zone in Warsaw will be CEST — Central European Summer Time and is equivalent to UTC/GMT +2 hours.

11. Electricity

In Poland, the voltage is 230V, 50 Hz. The plug is the standard European double plug.

12. Currency

The currency in Poland is the Polish Złoty (PLN) 1 PLN = 100 groszy. The current exchange rate as of 27 September 2023 is US 1 = 4,40 PLN and $\in 1 = 4,63$ PLN (rates are subject to change, source: <u>www.xe.com</u>). Currency exchanges are available at airport and in hotels.

13. Additional information

In Poland, smoking cigarettes at public transport stops and in clubs, pubs and restaurants (unless there are separate rooms for smokers) is prohibited. Drinking alcohol in public places (parks, squares, streets, etc.) outside of designated places such as summer gardens in certain restaurants, pubs and Vistula boulevards is also prohibited.
