

NbS Examples Submitted by Kuwait to the Intergovernmental Consultations on Nature-based Solutions

Kuwait currently has a number of ongoing planting projects to address challenges. So far, we have planted approximately 8000 - 10,000 mangrove trees throughout different areas of Kuwait since 2018. The locations include AlJahra coastline, Bubyah Island, Subhiya area, and near the Kazma Bay area; the project is still ongoing. Kuwait is also working on planting Ziziphus trees in its desert regions and so far, we have planted approximately 15,000 plants (over 4 different phases) mainly in the AlJahra region; the project is ongoing. We also have proposals to plant different kinds of native plants in the desert areas of Kuwait and in the coastal areas to combat climate change, desertification, and sandstorms, as well as improve the quality of biodiversity in Kuwait.
