Excellency,

On behalf of the Republic of Tajikistan, we are pleased to submit our initial input for the zero draft of the UNEA-7 Ministerial Declaration, aligning with the theme "Advancing Sustainable Solutions for a Resilient Planet."

We wish to highlight the outcomes of the **High-Level International Conference on Glaciers' Preservation**, which will take place from **May 29 to June 1, 2025** in Dushanbe, Tajikistan. This conference builds upon **UNGA Resolution No. A/Res/77/158, adopted on December 14, 2022, at the 77th session**, which, at the initiative of Tajikistan, declared **2025 the International Year of Glaciers' Preservation**. The resolution recognizes the critical importance of glacier preservation for global climate resilience, freshwater security, and sustainable development.

Key messages and recommendations from the conference will focus on:

- 1. Urgent Actions for Glacier Protection Strengthening global efforts in monitoring, adaptation strategies, and cross-border cooperation for glacier preservation.
- 2. Integration of Glacial Ecosystems into Climate Policies Promoting glacier preservation in national and international climate adaptation and mitigation frameworks.
- 3. **Sustainable Water Management** Addressing the link between glacier loss, freshwater security, and socio-economic stability, particularly for vulnerable regions.
- 4. **Innovative Financing for Glacial Conservation** Advocating for increased financial and technical support, including through climate funds and international partnerships.

Given the growing urgency of climate change impacts on cryosphere systems, we propose that the ministerial declaration reflect these key priorities and call for **enhanced global cooperation and commitments** in addressing glacier loss. Tajikistan remains committed to working with UNEA-7 and all Member States to drive forward concrete, action-oriented solutions.

We look forward to contributing further as the consultation process progresses.
