1	Governance	 Measures to strengthen the Barcelona Convention/MAP Governance including strengthening cooperation with Components, Host Country Agreements, Other mandated actions, Common date to hold national events to celebrate 40th Anniversary of Barcelona Convention, and Date and venue of next Ordinary Meeting of the Contracting Parties to Barcelona Convention and its Protocols.
2	Reporting	 Adoption of the draft revised format of the Barcelona Convention Reporting System, and New reporting format for the ICZM Protocol (Operational Section).
3	Compliance Committee	 Election and/ or renewal of members, Adoption of the Compliance Committee Recommendations, and Programme of Work of the Compliance Committee.
4	Cooperation Agreements and MAP Partners	 Adoption of new cooperation agreements, including cooperation in the field of prevention, preparedness and response to marine pollution from ships (European Commission, European Maritime Safety Agency - EMSA and the oil industry). Addition of new MAP NGO Partners.
5	MCSD Governance	Adoption of revised constitutive documents and new composition of MCSD.
6	Mediterranean Strategy for Sustainable Development 2016-2025	Adoption of the MSSD 2016-2025.
7	Integrated Monitoring and Assessment Programme of the Mediterranean Sea and Coast and related assessment criteria	Establishment of an integrated monitoring and assessment programme 2016- 2021, which for the first time in the Mediterranean, will cover the monitoring and assessment of biodiversity and Non-Indigenous Species, pollution and marine litter, coast and hydrography, based on common regional indicators, targets and good environmental status descriptions.
